Broom Swept

One Final Walkthrough

Per the purchase agreement you need to leave the house in 'broom swept' condition. This means ALL items...trash, wood piles, inherited items left when you bought, etc. are removed from the home, garage, yard, & outbuilding(s). Then, please do one final sweep/vacuuming of the entire house.

Leave a note for the buyer if you left the trash bin full at the curb to be picked up.

If you are ready sooner, please let us know in advance!

If you regularly have roto-rooter, sprinkler maintenance, or other yearly services- please leave a note on the counter or send us an email to pass the information along to the new owner. What would you want to know?

Keys & Utilities

Please hide one key for the buyer to find. All extra keys and garage door openers can be left on the kitchen counter.

You must keep utilities turned on and lawn + snow care must remain in effect until the day of possession transfer.

What to Leave Behind

- Shelving and TV mounts attached to the wall.
- Current/usable touch up paint
- Extra tiles/flooring that are current to the house
- Shower curtain rods and all window treatments

DON'T LEAVE...

- Old paint that is no longer useful.
- Old construction materials, boxes, chemicals, or anyting else behind.
- Remove ALL ITEMS under the sink, in the garage, storage shed, or the basement.
- Any furniture, appliances or items not listed in the contract

Additional Items To Leave Behind

- All Keys to house and any extra keys to outbuildings or sheds. If there is a keypad code or Ring Doorbell, please provide instructions on how to change the code.
- 2+ garage door openers
- Manuals to appliances left on kitchen counter
- All appliances and items as specified in the purchase agreement
- · Screens to windows
- · Lawn mowed, leaves removed, or snow plowed/shoveled
